



WHAT TO BRING TO SCHOOL

The following list is to help guide your packing. Please make sure to pack the **bolded items**.

CLOTHING

Laundry and dry cleaning are picked up once a week. Each student should have adequate clothing for a 2-week period. All articles of clothing should be marked with the student's name.

- Several shirts with collar
- 2 pairs of athletic sneakers
- 2 Blazer/ sport coat (one must be navy blue)
- 6 pairs of casual slacks (class dress)
- 4 pairs of dress slacks (one must be gray)
- 7 dress shirts, button-down
- Ties, several
- Underwear
- 2-3 Belts
- 1 dozen pairs of dress socks
- 2 dozen pairs of casual socks
- Sport practice clothing shirts/shorts
- 1 pair of dress shoes, loafers or oxfords or bucks
- Shower shoes/sandals
- Swimsuit
- Waterproof jacket/ umbrella

Seasonal clothing should be brought to school after the corresponding school recesses and not at the beginning of the year.

TOWELS & BEDDING

- 3 Bath towels
- 2 Hand towels
- 2 Wash cloths
- 1 bedspread or comforter
- 3 sets of sheets – Standard twin size
- 1-2 Light-weight blanket
- 1 Pillow with 2 pillow cases
- Mattress pad

TOILETRIES

- Nail clippers
- Shampoo and conditioner
- Soap/ shower gel
- Toothpaste/ toothbrush/ dental floss
- Razor/ Electric shaver
- Deodorant
- Hairbrush
- Shower caddy
- Mouthwash
- Sunscreen

MISCELLANEOUS

- Alarm clock (not on phone)
- Headphones
- Laundry bag/ Hamper
- Bicycle, helmet, & bike lock
- Desk/ bedside lamp (not halogen)
- Hangers (*please bring a limited number*)
- Lock box
- Mirror
- Personal items from home
- Small fan
- Wall décor and non-marking adhesive/accessories

SCHOOL SUPPLIES

- Pens & pencils
- Highlighter (assorted)
- Calculator (graphing recommended)
- Pencil sharpener
- Loose leaf paper (additional)

ITEMS SUPPLIED BY THE SCHOOL:

- Binders (1/class)
- Homework planner
- Loose leaf paper
- Textbooks
- Dividers

NO folders and spiral notebooks, please.

TECHNOLOGY
